PA I = Cadette Program Aide, PA II) = Senior Program Aide)

STEP 1: Girls that have earned the PA I and are interested in earning the PA II must complete another specialization. This specialization will be of your choice. You must choose an area that you may receive training in and become more competent in that area. An example would be cake decorating. You could take a class at Michaels to become more knowledgeable in this area and be able to teach others. Your training must first be approved by the council before you take it.
